

162FW DETACHMENT 1 OPERATION SNOWBIRD,

THIS IS A “PRIORITY SELECT” ANNOUNCEMENT FOR ONE PERSONNEL POSITION IN SUPPORT OF OPERATION SNOWBIRD, A NATIONAL GUARD BUREAU (NGB) PROGRAM. DUE TO THE NATURE OF THIS POSITION, IN ADDITION TO PERSONNEL SKILLS WE ARE SEEKING APPLICANTS WITH SKILLS IN AVIATION RESOURCE MANAGEMENT, SCHEDULING, AND SECURITY MANAGEMENT.

THIS IS A TEMPORARY ACTIVE DUTY SPECIAL TRAINING DAY POSITION NOT TO EXCEED (NTE) 30 SEPTEMBER 2014. THIS TOUR MAY BE EXTENDED IF PROGRAM IS CONTINUED. THIS POSITION IS AVAILABLE TO CURRENT MEMBERS OF THE 162FW, MSGT OR TSGT (IMMEDIATELY PROMOTABLE TO MSGT).

NATIONAL GUARD REQUIREMENTS:

1. If selected you must be in compliance with physical fitness, height, weight, and body fat measurement standards. You must have completed a medical examination in accordance with AFI 48-123 within 18 months preceding your entry into this tour. Women will be tested for pregnancy before entering into this tour.
2. Individual must possess a Secret Security Clearance.
3. Must meet eligibility requirements of AFM 36-2108 (Airman Classification) and ANGI 36-101 (The Active Guard/Reserve Program).
4. This tour is affected by the “1095 rule” which states this tour cannot last longer than 3 years or 1,095 days.

SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE

1. Good verbal and written communication skills (must be able to speak publicly to large groups, conduct briefings and Flightline tours).
2. Knowledge of flight and operations.
3. Basic knowledge of information systems technologies, protocols, and standards required to integrate and sustain common client-level voice, data, and video devices.
4. Knowledge of networking skills necessary to ensure systems can be interfaced with Davis-Monthan Infrastructure.

JOB DESCRIPTION

This job position is at Operation Snowbird Davis-Monthan Air Force Base which is a generic military flight operations/maintenance facility. Responsibilities are to provide liaison and advisory assistance to all deployed units, Luke Airspace and Range Management with 355 OG, 162 OG / OGV Airspace Managers, ARNG helicopter and other fighter units. Schedules range and airspace for deployed units and provides updates. Other duties include primary GPC card holder, Equipment Custodian and Orders Clerk. Operation Snowbird provides various support for 12-14 units each year who utilize the facilities to meet their training requirements. Personnel assigned to Operation Snowbird are responsible, but not limited to: Assist visiting units with coordination of airlift arrival and departure, coordinate and present briefings for visiting units. Personnel assigned to Operation Snowbird will report directly to the Snowbird NCOIC. Work schedules fluctuate and weekend work (other than drill) is sometimes required. Operation Snowbird personnel will be required to meet UTA Drill requirements that may not always coincide with the 162 FW Master Drill schedule.

NOTES

1) Upon selection, the member will vacate their military position and be re-assigned to a Master Sergeant position under temporary conditions at Operation Snowbird. If a technician is selected and promoted to Master Sergeant while on this tour they have restoration rights under USERRA to their previously held "technician" position, or a position of like seniority, status and pay; depending upon the length of their military service (5 CFR, Part 353.205 thru 353.207). There is no guarantee that you will be returned as your promoted military grade. Upon hiring in Operation Snowbird's MSgt position, they will be informed in writing of their restoration rights and acknowledge such notice. If Operation Snowbird is discontinued or the commander and/or member elect to discontinue member's service the individual may return to their technician status, separate, or retire. Please note there is a possibility that you may be returned to the military grade you held prior to accepting this position.

- 1) Selection for this position requires declaration of Arizona state residency at the time of in-processing, and maintaining that residency while on this tour.
- 2) Member must provide emergency contact numbers for 24/7-365 emergency recall.
- 3) Individual must possess or qualify for a SECRET security clearance.
- 4) Member must have a passing Fitness score.
