

# **Mandatory Medical Treatment Reporting Requirements**

IAW AFI 48-123, *Medical Examinations and Standards*, para 11.4.2 and AFI 10-203, *Duty Limiting Conditions*, para 2.18.1, military personnel must report any new medical condition, medical conditions that potentially affect deployability, or any change in medical status, and all medical/dental treatment obtained through civilian sources to the appropriate medical provider (162d Medical Group).

**162d military technicians and Drill Status Guardsman (DSG)** must report any medical condition, medical conditions that potentially affect deployability, or any change in medical status, to the appropriate medical provider (162d Medical Group). In addition, personnel must also report all medical/dental treatment obtained through civilian sources to the 162d Medical Group.

**162d Active Guard Reserve (AGR) personnel** are authorized to receive their medical care through the 355<sup>th</sup> Medical Group at Davis-Monthan AFB medical treatment facility. IAW ANGI 36-101, *The AGR Program*, Chapter 12, AGR personnel must inform the servicing ANG medical facility (162d Medical Group) of any changes in their medical status. Prompt identification of medical issues that may impact continued worldwide service will facilitate effective management of these cases and ensure consideration of all benefits and entitlements in the event that a Medical Evaluation Board is required.

IAW ANGI 36-101, para 12.3.3, AGR personnel who schedule elective surgery without approval of the Air/Detachment/Mission Commander may be considered an abuse of privileges and may result in disciplinary action.

AGRs who receive medical/dental care or prescription medications from civilian healthcare providers must inform their Primary Care Manager at the 355<sup>th</sup> Medical Group at Davis-Monthan to ensure this information is documented in their medical/dental record.

**NOTE:** **\*\*If you are a DSG and your spouse is AGR, it is your responsibility to bring all your medical and prescription information into the MDG for input to your medical record here. \*\***
