UNDERGRADUATE PILOT TRAINING (UPT) OPPORTUNITY FOR THE 162nd WG ***162nd Wing Military Announcement*** (Military Applicants Only)

*The 162nd Wing is seeking eligible applicants for the position of
Undergraduate Pilot Training (UPT) AFSC: 18RX (MQ-1)
(Traditional Guard position w/approx. 1 yr. on Active Duty for training)*

To be eligible: You must be a military member of the 162 Wing no older than 26 years of age who has not already completed any portion of UPT, must possess a bachelor's degree. The 162 Wing desires current or potential officer applicants who exemplify the Air Force core values and possess the motivation/desire to become an Air National Guard Predator Pilot – MQ-1.

To apply you must submit the following:

- A Letter of Intent
- Resume
- Official consolidated transcripts from an accredited four-year degree granting college
Official transcripts must be mailed to MSgt Veronica Daniel-Aragon (see address below) from the college.
- AF Form 2030, USAF Drug and Alcohol Abuse Certificate
- AF Form 24, Application for Appointment as a Reserve of the Air Force
- AF Form 215, Aircrew Training Candidate Data Summary
- Copy of Private Pilot License (if applicable, not required)
- Two Letters of Recommendation (preferred, not required)
- AFOQT and PCSM Scores

*Minimum required scores for members possessing a bachelor's degree:
VERB = 15, QUANT = 10, PILOT = 25*

To schedule testing for the AFOQT / PCSM, please contact nearest Air Force Base Promotions and Testing section (Davis-Monthan AFB, 520-228-5191). You must have a letter of recommendation from your squadron/flight commander to be administered these test. This letter should state that you are an officer candidate and the commander requests that you be administered the AFOQT / PCSM.

You must meet the following requirements:

- **Applicant must possess at least an ENTNAC or a NAC security clearance. For award and retention of 18RX, completion of a current Single Scope Background Investigation (SSBI) is mandatory**
- **If selected for the position, you must be medically qualified IAW AFI 48-123, and must meet the weight/fitness requirements of AFI 36-2905**
