



LEGAL ASSISTANCE

The Office of the Staff Judge Advocate provides legal assistance to members, retirees and their dependents with a valid military ID.

This assistance includes wills, powers of attorney, notary services, family care plans, casualty affairs, employment problems arising from the performance of military duty and subject to the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Acts (USERRA), landlord tenant problems related to deployment, and matters arising from the performance of military duty and subject to the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act (SCRA). The 162nd Legal Office cannot provide legal assistance to members facing military justice or civilian criminal prosecution, claims against the Government, or private business efforts.

For wills, living wills, and healthcare powers of attorney, please go to <https://aflegalassistance.law.af.mil>. On this page, select "Legal Worksheets." Select the appropriate document and complete it on-line. You will be given a ticket number (note that it is case sensitive). When you make your appointment, please give us your ticket number. We will start working on your will before your appointment and save you time.

We can usually complete your will in one visit. A member of our staff will create your will from the worksheet you provide and through consultation with you. We will then execute your will with a notary and two witnesses. Plan to spend approximately an hour in our office to complete the entire process. If both you and your spouse would like wills, you both must fill out a will worksheet, send it in and come to our office for an appointment.
