SUBJECT: Undergraduate Flying Training Board Exceptions to Policy Requests for Age and Total Federal Commissioned Service

Effective immediately, undergraduate flying training applicants who are under the age of 33 and/or have less than 8 years of total federal commissioned service (TFCS) may apply without an exception to policy. This memo modifies paragraph 3.1.1.1. of AFI 36-2105, *Applying for Flying Training, Air Battle Manager, and Astronaut Programs*, which states that individuals who are beyond their 30th birthday and/or have greater than 5 years Total Federal Commissioned Service require an exception-to-policy to be considered for Pilot, Remotely Piloted Aircraft (RPA) Pilot, Combat Systems Officer (CSO), or Air Battle Manager (ABM) undergraduate flying training (UFT).

AFI 36-2105 will be incorporated into a new consolidated publication which will implement new parameters for applying to UFT. The new guidance will reflect that individuals who are beyond their 33d birthday and/or have greater than 8 years TFCS will require an exception to policy under provisions in AFI 36-2105.

This exception will remain in effect for one year as of the date of this memo, or until the release of the new consolidated publication, whichever is sooner.
